

## FORMALDEHYDE TRAINING SYLLABUS

**Description:** Training will inform employees of the hazards associated with formaldehyde and any products that may contain formaldehyde. The exposure effects and methods to reduce or prevent exposure will be covered, also safe work practices when working in areas that may contain formaldehyde. OSHA standard 29 CFR 1910.1048
