

HAZARD COMMUNICATION TRAINING SYLLABUS

Description: Training will provide information on the hazards when working with or around any chemical. The course informs trainees that OSHA standard 1910.1200 Hazard Communication is any employee’s “right to know” standard and will relay that training is required around any hazard, chemical, or hazardous materials.

Course start time: 7:30am – 4:00pm CBT Lab hours

Course Length: Approximately 30-50 minutes including test. (Course is 22 minutes in length)

Presentation Method: CBT – Computer Based Training

Audience: Any contractor whose will be working with or around any chemicals.

Objectives: Upon completion of the course, trainees will have a general awareness knowledge of the following:

1. OSHA standard 1910.1200 HAZCOM is “Your right to know”
2. Identify site exposure, labeling, and safety data sheet
3. Location of SDS
4. Identify chemicals at the job site
5. PPE and protection from exposures
6. Emergency procedures for possible leaks and spills

Test Information: Test consist of 20 questions and will require 70% or higher to pass the course.
